



Call for Submissions: PREMIER issue: *wordriver*

wordriver is a new literary journal dedicated to the poetry, short fiction and creative nonfiction of adjuncts and part-time instructors teaching in our universities, colleges, and community colleges. Our premier issue will be published in Spring 2009. We're looking for work that demonstrates the creativity and craft of adjunct/part-time instructors in English and other disciplines. We reserve first publication rights and onetime anthology publication rights for all work published.

Submission Deadline for the premier issue of *wordriver* is October 31, 2008.

Submission Guidelines

- **All submissions must be sent by email as Word.docs. MS Word 2003 or earlier (no Vista) or .pdf files**

Poetry: Maximum 5 poems (60 lines or less). Send all poems as attachments in Microsoft Word format (see above) to one email. Include your name, address, phone number, and email address in the body of your email, as well as a short bio listing your university, college, or community college affiliation and your department and any previous publishing history. **Do not** put your name or personal information on your attachment(s).

The subject line of your submission email should contain: wordriverPoetrySub. We do not accept simultaneous submissions.

Short Fiction: Maximum 2 submissions (10 typed, double-spaced pages each). Send all poems as attachments in Microsoft Word format (see above) to one email. Include your name, address, phone number, and email address in the body of your email, as well as a short bio listing your university, college, community college affiliation and your department and any previous publishing history. **Do not** put your name or personal information on your attachment(s). The subject line of your submission email should contain: wordriverFictionSub. We do not accept simultaneous submissions.

Creative Nonfiction: Maximum 2 submissions (10 typed, double-spaced pages each). Send all poems as attachments in Microsoft Word format (see above) to one email. Include your name, address, phone number, and email address in the body of your email, as well as a short bio listing your university, college, community college affiliation and your department and any previous publishing history. **Do not** put your name or personal information on your attachment(s). The subject line of your submission email should contain: wordriverNonfictionSub. We do not accept simultaneous submissions.
